

Spring is here, now what do I do with all the yard waste?

Jefferson Hills will have a drop-off dumpster for your yard waste at the Public Works Complex back parking lot the **second** weekend of every month from June to September during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. You may bring your yard waste and dispose of it in bio-degradable bags. If you don't have the bio-degradable bags, you can put the yard waste in any container, but you will not be able to put the containers in the bin.

Yard waste includes: grass clippings, leaves, weeds, hedge cuttings, limbs and branches not to exceed 3 inches in diameter or 48 inches in length.

During the month of May, your regular hauler will pick up your spring yard waste of twigs and debris during your regular trash pick-up; opposite weeks of recycling pick-up. During the last week of October and November your regular haulers will pick up all your leaf waste during your regular trash pick-up, as per your recycling calendar.
