Sealed Proposals will be received by The Borough of Jefferson Hills, at the Municipal Building, 925 Old Clairton Road, Jefferson Hills, PA 15025 until 10:30 a.m. prevailing time on Wednesday, July 31, 2024 to be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter for the following project:

ANDREW REILLY MEMORIAL PARK RESTROOM ADA IMPROVEMENTS – 2022-GEDTF-145

Base Bid

This project includes the ADA Improvements to the existing restroom building; removal and replacement of 4” concrete sidewalk; installation, maintenance, and removal of Erosion and Sedimentation controls; Site Preparation, Site Restoration and Clean-up, complete in place.

Add Alternate Bid No. 1 – ADA Parking Option 1

Includes the installation of 6” concrete ADA Parking Slabs; installation of concrete curb; placing of concrete wheel stops; line striping and ADA signage, installation of Bituminous Asphalt Transition, and installation, maintenance, and removal of Erosion and Sedimentation controls; Site Preparation, Site Restoration and Clean-up, complete in place.

Add Alternate Bid No. 1 – ADA Parking Option 2

Includes the installation of 6” concrete ADA Parking Slabs; installation of concrete curb; placing of concrete wheel stops; line striping and ADA signage, installation of Bituminous Asphalt Transition, and installation, maintenance, and removal of Erosion and Sedimentation controls; Site Preparation, Site Restoration and Clean-up, complete in place.

All Proposals must be in the hands of Michael S. Glister, P.E., Acting Borough Manager, Borough of Jefferson Hills, 925 Old Clairton Road, Jefferson Hills, PA 15025 on or before 10:30 A.M. prevailing time, July 31, 2024. Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the words "ANDREW REILLY MEMORIAL PARK RESTROOM ADA IMPROVEMENTS – 2022-GEDTF-145".

Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreement are on file and open to public inspection at the office of The Gateway Engineers, Inc., 100 McMorris Road Pittsburgh, PA 15205 where sets of said documents may be obtained upon payment of \$50.00 per set. No refund will be made for the return of any documents. An additional \$10.00 will be required for each set of plans if they are to be mailed. Electronic copies will be made available at no cost upon request.

A Non-Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on site at 318 Wray Drive, Jefferson Hills, PA 15025 on Tuesday, July 17, 2024 at 10:30 AM.

Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of the Borough of Jefferson Hills in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within fifteen (15) days after Notice of the Award of the Contract.

Pennsylvania Prevailing Wages must be paid on this contract.

"Compliance is required with the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of 1961, P.L. 987, No. 442; Title VI and other applicable provisions of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; the Department of Labor Equal Opportunity Clause (41 CFR 60 -1.4); Executive Order 11625 (Utilization of Minority Business Enterprise); Executive Order 12138 (Utilization of Female Business Enterprise); in compliance with Section 504 of Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; the Allegheny County MBE/WBE Program enacted July, 1981, which sets forth goals of 13 percent Minority and 2 percent Female Business Enterprise; and the Allegheny County Ordinance #6867-12, setting forth goals of 5 percent Veteran Owned Small Businesses."

The Proposals must be made to the Borough of Jefferson Hills, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and shall remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days. No Bidder may withdraw his Proposal during the sixty (60) day period without forfeiting his Bid guarantee.

Performance, Maintenance, and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement upon acceptance of the Proposal from the successful Bidder.

The Borough reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, or any part thereof, for any reason, and also reserves the right to waive any informality therein.

The Bidder is advised that the Borough will award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder based on the total bid submitted. However, The Borough expressly reserves the right to reject all bids, and specifically reserves the right to award to the lowest responsible bidder a contract for all or any portions of the work listed in the proposal, and in awarding a contract for less than the total work listed, or less than all portions of the work listed, the contract price will be determined from the total quantities for each item listed and the unit price bid for each item listed.
