23. Reports

Chief Roach:

- Police activities spiked because of the storms. He met with PEMA to try to get reimbursed for damage to the Borough. If the County reaches a certain threshold, we will then be eligible for reimbursement.
- August 24th is the first step for the SHACOG police officer testing
- Vandalism at Beedle Park included overturning a couple of port-a-johns and unbolted some of the playground equipment. Mr. Cohen:
- There is an opportunity for a grant from the Allegheny County Department of Development and Planning to assist the Borough in completing the update of its Zoning and Subdivision ordinances. It provides up to 75% funding towards the total project costs. It was Council's consensus for Mr. Cohen to move forward

and prepare the grant application, and have the resolution ready for next month's agenda.

Mr. McCreery:

- Met with Greg Jones, of the Economic Development South to further explore joining.
- Met with Chief Roach, Mr. Lovell, and Senator Matt Smith on the Walton Road issues.
- The third-party engineer advised the most cost-effective option for sewage processing in the West Elizabeth watershed is WESA. Council agreed to a meeting with Borough Council, the WESA Board of Directors and Rick Barnett, as per the scope of work.

24. General Business

Mr. Khalil asked if the Comprehensive Plan is on track, Mr. McCreery suggested Mr. Cohen prepare a presentation on the status to be presented to Council at the October or November meeting.

Mr. Montgomery advised Mr. Reis, Code Enforcement Officer, came before the Planning Commission requesting we update our Property Maintenance Code. After the Planning Commission makes their recommendations, it will come before Council for approval.

Mr. King adjourned the meeting at 8:35 p.m. with an executive session to follow concerning legal and personnel matters on motion by Mr. Khalil, seconded by Mrs. Ielase and carried unanimously.
