



## SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

One Container. No Sorting......No Kidding!

The easiest way to recycle is here.
Offered by Republic Services!

Place all your recyclable materials in your recycling container with no separating or sorting needed. We'll do it for you! Just a few simple guidelines outlined below to avoid any service interruptions:

- Place all your recyclable material in your <u>RECYCLE</u> container(s) furnished by the municipality without separating or sorting! The containers need to be clearly marked as recyclable materials.
- Large volumes of glass and newspaper can increase the weight of your recycling container(s). Please assure the weight of one container doesn't exceed 50-pounds.
- All cardboard must be broken down flat, shall be no more than 3-feet in length or width, and bundle if outside of recycling container. Since most recycling containers don't have lids we recommend bundling or using paper bags for cardboard and paper to eliminate litter on windy days.

## YES!

- Glass bottles and jars
- Metal beverage and food cans
- Aluminum cans
- o Plastic bottles (Nos. 1 through 7)
- Paper from news, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, dry non-coated food paper
- Boxboard from tissues, dryer sheets, tooth paste, cereal boxes, spaghetti, cracker and other dry foods boxes
- All cardboard must be broken down so that it is flat and no more than 3feet in length and bundled.
- Phone books, paperback books, shredded paper

## NO!

- Garbage, food waste, diapers, paper plates, hangers, old plastic toys
- Meat or Cheese plastic wrapping or paper packaging
- Wax or plastic wrap or bags
- Freezer food packaging
- Plastic deli, product or take-out packaging or utensils
- Plastic bags or wrapping film
- Formed or pellet styrofoam packaging
- Window glass, ceramics or dishware, mirrors, light bulbs
- Garbage bags, white, green or black
